Associate Membership may be granted to individuals employed by police agencies in the province or those involved in a specified sphere of law enforcement whose membership would support the Association's objectives.

- Associate Membership is intended for individuals whose work aligns with and contributes to the objectives of the Association and public safety priorities. Membership is not intended to serve as a platform for commercial marketing, promotion, or business development.



PURPOSE OF THE SOCIETY

The purposes of the Society, as the united voice of police in British Columbia, are:

1. Advocating for equitable, inclusive, effective and efficient public safety policies and best practices.
2. Building community partnerships to support public safety.
3. Encouraging and developing co-operation among Members to achieve common goals and foster uniform police practices.
4. Promoting integrity, honour and ethical conduct.
5. Transacting any and all other lawful business for which non-profit organizations may be incorporated pursuant to the laws of the Societies Act of BC, and the Business Corporations Act of BC, both as amended from time to time, as well as any successor acts.

ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

Active Membership shall be restricted to the following applicants while serving in office:

- The Chief Constables, Deputy Chief Constables, Superintendents and Inspectors of each municipal police agency established in British Columbia.
- The Chief Officer, Deputy Chief Officers, Superintendents and Inspectors of the South Coast British Columbia Transportation Authority Police Service.
- The Chief Officer, Deputy Chief Officers, Superintendents and Inspectors of the Stl'at'imx Tribal Police.
- The Officer in Charge and Commissioned Officers of the BC Combined Forces Special Enforcement Unit.
- "E" Division Royal Canadian Mounted Police Commanding Officer.
- "M" Division, Royal Canadian Mounted Police Commanding Officer and Criminal Operations Officers.
- "E" Division OIC of a Royal Canadian Mounted Police Detachment and/or a Commissioned Officer (Inspector and above) Unit Commander of a Specialized Unit as approved by the "E" Division Commanding Officer, including but not limited to:
 - Officer in Charge, Criminal Operations (Core)
 - Officer in Charge, Criminal Operations (ISOC)
 - Officer in Charge, Federal Policing (D/Crops)
 - Officer in Charge, Criminal Operations (D/Crops)

- Officer in Charge, Specialized Investigative (D/Crops)
 - Officer in Charge, Operations Strategy Branch
 - Officer in Charge, Human Resources
 - Officer in Charge, “E” Division Major Crime Section
 - Officer in Charge, “E” Division Intelligence Officer
 - Officer in Charge, Provincial Traffic Services
 - Officer in Charge, Integrated Homicide Investigation Team
 - Officer in Charge, LMD Integrated Teams
- District Commanders and Assistant District Commanders of “E” Division Royal Canadian Mounted Police.
 - The Officer in Charge and Commissioned Officers of Royal Canadian Mounted Police Municipal Detachments.
 - The Officer in Charge, Pacific Region Training Centre, Royal Canadian Mounted Police.
 - The Director, Justice Institute of British Columbia, Police Academy.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Associate Membership may be granted to applicants employed by police agencies in the province or who are involved in a restricted sphere of law enforcement and whose membership would contribute to the objectives of the Association.

Associate Membership is not intended for marketing, promotion, or business development purposes.

For greater certainty this includes:

- The senior person responsible for security in British Columbia for financial institutions of the Bank Act.
- One security representative from banks that carry on business in British Columbia.
- Senior officials of the government of Canada and British Columbia and of Crown Corporations of Canada and British Columbia who have a significant role in law enforcement.
- Police officers employed by police agencies in the province who do not otherwise qualify to be Active Members
- Civilian professionals employed by police agencies in the province who do not otherwise qualify to be Active Members.
- But does not include individuals whose involvement in law enforcement is primarily commercial in nature.
